Ground Rules for PCRC:

1. Each protocol must have specific testable hypothesis with data available in MPOG data structure
2. People requesting specific data elements must also supply that data type to MPOG. If you don't submit that data type currently, then you can't get that type of data type out. However, if you have a co-investigator from another site that does supply that data, then you can ask for that type of data. The reason is so someone on the research team understands the limitations of each data element being requested and used
3. To ensure that there is not a lack of clarity about what the status of the proposal is, each proposal will get the following overall decision at the end of each presentation and discussion
 - a. Accept with minimal or no changes required
 - i. E-mail revision to PCRC
 - b. Accept with moderate changes required

- i. Represent at a future PCRC
 - ii. E-mail Revisions to PCRC
 - c. Revise and reconsider at future meeting
 - d. Reject

 - 2. No disagreement with this
 - iv. History tab
 - 1. No sites need case specific access to audit history from History Tab now, but would like in a future version
 - v. Re- upload options
 - 1. Applying to all destinations makes sense (Dan). Want fidelity between both databases.
 - 2. Need to reach out to Samba/AQI and other destination to let them know they may be getting updates to cases. – Sachin/Nirav
 - vi. General Questions
 - 1. Wietze: Will date range appear for Test uploads? Yes.
 - 2. Need to consider adding date range for production data as well - Mark
 - 3. E-mail reminder flag to submit data? Several yes. No dissenters.
 - b. Case validation utility
 - i. Feedback: Dan: model is only for 20/ 6 month. Consider a more frequent model with same number of cases (i.e 4/month or 10/quarter) - Mark
 - ii. QI data needs to validated more frequently (monthly). Should be part of e-mail reminders – Mark/Tory
 - c. Web based concept browser
 - i. Agreement to keep site specific data behind user name and password
 - ii. Agreement to keep aggregate counts available without user name and password
