- Support Education (GME + CME) as a new focus for MPOG




Precision Feedback Study

- Aim 1: Preference Survey: ~1k
 providers responded
- Aim 2: Precision Service application built by Department of Learning Health Sciences team
- Aim 3: RCT of 46 centers randomized to either precision feedback or standard feedback




QI Reporting Tool – Health System View

2025 Plans

 Keep the lights on... new measures, measure review, measure retirements, subcommittee work

- Convene Ad Hoc Workgroup to understand requirements for resident / fellow inclusion in QI efforts
- Wrap up major development in QI Reporting and pivot to DataDirect
- Develop visualization relevant for health equity initiatives
- Registry integration for QI (continued!)
- Plan for PROs
- Learn about QI for Regional Anesthesia
