









Surgical Site Infection

Intent of Variable: To capture the outcome of Superficial Incisional, Deep Incisional or Organ/Space Surgical Site Infection (SSI) which is a substantial cause of morbidity, prolonged hospitalization, and death, and the costliest healthcare-acquired infection type.

Definition: A surgical site infection (SSI) is an infection that occurs after the principal operative procedure in the part of the body/incision where that surgery took place. Deep Incisional SSIs are typically more severe than the Superficial SSI category. Organ/Space SSIs are typically the most severe and are more likely to require procedural intervention.

Number of SSI: 3 (4%)




ASPIRE Average: 8%

SSI-01-MSQC: Surgical Site Infection, Colectomy More Info

This measure is based on SSI data obtained from the Michigan Surgical Quality Collaborative (MSQC). MSQC sites (~70 across Michigan) extract data from a representative sample of colectomy cases. We have matched this sample of cases to ASPIRE cases. Please note this measure will likely not reflect all the colectomy cases at your institution. Additionally, there are MSQC hospitals that are not members of ASPIRE and not represented in the performance benchmarks.












