5. Peds Subgroup Update

- a. PUL 01 requires additional modification for pediatrics to calculate Ideal Body Weight for children 12-17 years old. Utilizing McClaren Method for Peds.
- 6. QCDR Update
 - a. Data Validation and Execution Report submitted and accepted by CMS for 2016.
 - b. 13 measures approved for reporting in 2017 (includes 3 MIPS measures).
 - c. Sites should update User Management Tool with provider contact information
 - d. Sites opting for individual reporting will have consents distributed this week.
 - e. CMS reduced the number of improvement activities required to 2 from 4 for non-patient facing providers.
 - f. QCDR Agreement to go out this month- revising for each site now. Ready in next 2-3 weeks.
