## Agenda & Notes

1. Announcements
  - a. Meeting Minutes from the May 25, 2016 Quality Committee Meeting approved.
  - b. Next Quarterly Meeting will be held on Sept 16 in Frankenmuth, MI in conjunction with MSQC. Dr. Kheterpal to be the featured anesthesiologist speaker.
  - c. MPOG Retreat will be held in October before the ASA Conference at the Marriott Hotel in Chicago from 730a-330p. Draft agenda posted on the website. Registration to open soon. Agenda to include:
    - i. Initiatives addressing the Opioid Epidemic and collaborative work occurring with surgical colleagues.
    - ii. New session: Best of MPOG. Participating members will give short presentations on the work occurring in both QI and research areas.

4. Cohort 2 Upload Status: July 1 Deadline.
  - a. All sites are on track to upload by the deadline. Sparrow and Beaumont-FH already uploaded.
  - b. Holland, Bronson, St. Mary's- Livonia, and SJMHS-Oakland on track to upload this week.
5. QCDR Update
  - a. Data Validation Execution Report submitted to CMS last week.
  - b. 2016 Provider Consents will be sent out this week. Dependent on Provider Contacts Tool being completed. Each Quality Champion to verify that Provider Contacts Tool is updated and ensure that anesthesia providers are completing consent forms as they are sent out. ASPIRE team to distribute 2 updates on which providers still require consents before the end of 2016. ASPIRE cannot submit data for any providers who have not submitted consent.
6. Education Modules: Dr. Leslie Jameson and her team are working on completing 4 modules by August 2016. Modules will be posted on the website. ASPIRE Team working to offer CME and MOCA certification. ASPIRE will look into obtaining CRNA certification credit as well. Topics include:
  - a. Glucose Management
  - b. Neuromuscular Blockade
  - c. Handoffs
  - d. Ventilation Management

7. Filters now available: standard filters published for all the measures. Measure-specific filters coming soon.
8. Handoff Measure Update: 2- part measure
  - a. Yes/No component
  - b. Audit component: list of appropriate data elements to be included in the handoff and a way to audit and submit documentation that an audit was completed.
  - c. Intraop and PACU Handoff measures to be built. ASPIRE working on Intraop measure first.
9. AKI 01 Measure now published.
  - a. ASPIRE now has published 3 outcome measure.
  - b. Examines patients with baseline creatinine levels and assess whether a 0.3 bump occurs within 48 hours or 50% increase in 7 days
  - c. Sites should review failed cases to ensure cases did not meet the measure specification.
  - d. New feature in Galileo coming soon: sample of passed and excluded cases will also be accessible in Galileo in the near future. Sites should review those cases as well to ensure the proper indications and exclusions are applied.
  - e. Risk adjustment algorithms will be published when they are finalized.
10. Randomization of Provider Feedback Emails to continue for participating sites for 6-9 months. Amy and Shelley conducting interim analysis of cohort 1 sites now. This analysis will help us determine if additional sites from Cohort 2 will need to participate as well. More information will be available after interim analysis is complete. QCDR providers are exempt. Both monthly and quarterly feedback sites can participate.
11. Knowledge sharing across collaborative.
  - a. Goal to use ASPIRE collaborative as a means of sharing the quality improvement initiatives across sites.
  - b. December Quarterly Meeting will allow time for sites to share their improvement activities. Please consider what your site can present/share with the collaborative. Sites to share just a few slides and ideally reserve time for discussion (10-15 minutes total/site).
